

HOW EXACTLY?

- From 20th of August 2025 all European Union Member States competent authorities will be accepting the electronic freight transport information from the economic operators.
- It will not become mandatory for the economic operators to operate on electronic documentation.
- eFTI Regulation and its implementation will bring an understanding on the data exchange Architecture and infrastructure.
- MAIN TEXT of the Regulation adopted in 2020, IMPLEMENTED AND DELEGATED ACTS still upcoming, expected in 2023 and 2024.







eFTI Regulation Implementation timeline











